

School ID Policy

School issued identification cards (IDs), are important in the school environment because of the ability to safely identify those individuals who have permission to be in the building. Failure to identify persons in the school may put students and staff at risk. It is our goal to keep STEM Launch K – 8 safe. Students are required to wear their ID on a STEM Launch issued lanyard around their neck with their photo visible, unobstructed and on the outermost garment.

Students who fail to wear their school issued ID properly, or forget to wear their school issued ID will be issued another ID. The first replacement is free, subsequent replacements will be issued at a cost of \$5. This can be paid in cash, or will be charged to the student's school account in Infinite Campus.

In addition to wearing a school issued ID at all times, students may not alter their ID in any way. This includes cutting, putting stickers on, drawing on, or coloring in. IDs must remain as issued with no alterations whatsoever. Student may not exchange, trade, borrow, or lend their ID to anyone. If this happens, the ID will be taken and returned only by the Main Office staff.

Superintendent Policy:

Code: 5060 – 5.0 All middle and high school students shall be required to wear an unaltered visible school issued photo identification card (ID) on a school issued lanyard on their outermost garment above the waist during school hours, or at such times, locations, and activities specifically identified by the building principal.
